Mike's leadership journey with MCCU spanned 16 impactful years, during which he served as Chairperson from 2019 to 2023. His tenure was defined by significant growth, as MCCU expanded from four to six locations and saw its assets grow 250% from \$103 million to \$360 million during this time.

Mike's impact extended far beyond numbers. His visionary leadership and unwavering dedication were pivotal in shaping MCCU's commitment to its members and the community.
